Vital Voters is your platform to let the world know about the issues that matter to young people today. Want to make and submit your own campaign film? Follow these simple instructions to get involved.



HINTS Make a storyboard & TIPS

- Think of a subject you're passionate about.
 It could be mental health, racism, plastic waste, whatever you want to tell the world about.
- Write a basic script which tells your story in the most interesting way.
- Make a storyboard draw some boxes and fill them with simple sketches of what you want to happen at key points during your film.
- Do you want to **add sound effects,** a voiceover and music? Why not try recording your own?

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- 1 Use your smartphone or tablet to create a film no longer than **three minutes** in length.
- **Submit your film** by filling in the submission form and uploading your file.
- The closing date for entries is **Friday 18 December 2020** at **5.00pm**.

- If you are under 16 years old, you will need to ask a parent or guardian for permission to take part.
- Don't give personal information in your film such as your school or contact details.
- Don't use your full name in your film. Use first names or nicknames only.
- If you don't want to appear on camera, use other techniques such as animation or photo montage to create your film.
- If your film is shown on PHM's website, you can ask us to take it down if you change your mind.
