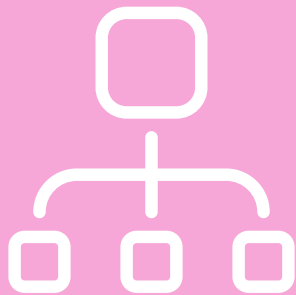


Multi-ended story: **step by step**

Step 1: **plan**

Look at the multi-ended story template.

A flowchart helps us to plan how our story will develop.



Each square (numbered one to seven) tells us what will happen in each chapter.

Step 3: **draw**

Draw a picture for each chapter to show what is happening in the story.



Create a story where the reader chooses their own journey!



Step 2: **write**

For each chapter on the flowchart, write a story on separate pieces of paper.

Write in the second person (you / yours) so the reader feels like the main character.

If you would like a little help with what to write, check out some writing inspiration.



Step 4: **order**



Place your chapters in order using the numbers on the template to guide you.

Next, at the end of each chapter, write which chapter number the reader needs to turn to depending which decision they make.

For example:

In the multi-ended story template, when the reader stumbles on a time machine, making the decision to go into the future will skip them past chapter three to chapter four.
